Outreach Funds Distribution

- The remaining balance, approximately \$4,500, to complete needs for Reverse Advent goals and to be divided among our Food Pantry partners: St. Cyprians, Food for Greater Elgin, and Ravenswood Community Services

Melissa Buckley moved, and Marisa Boynton seconded, that distribution of the remainder of the 2023 funds be approved as requested by the Outreach Committee. Upon a voice vote: All Ayes; No Nays. Motion carried.

Carols service was great; and attendance and vibrancy at Sunday services has been increasing. Fr. Perkins advised that he has submitted his doctorate program application.

Fr. Perkins asked that anyone interested in being a delegate to the 2024 Diocesan Convention contact Fr. Swarthout. Also, he requested Vestry members to let him know if there is interest in having a Vestry retreat in 2024.

Fr. Perkins noted that the Visioning Team is continuing its work and had good meetings this fall.
