
Every year, St. Michael's allocates 10% of our pledged income to Outreach. We also are blest to receive donations from individual members to the Outreach fund. On behalf of our membership, the Outreach Committee reviews submitted grants and, twice a year, decides how to allocate these funds.

In April, the Outreach Grant Committee met to allocate funds for the first half of 2024. Consistent with past years, the amount of funds requested far exceeded our budget of \$62,000. With that in mind, we decided to focus on organizations:


- That provide food & shelter to those in need
- Where our grant will make a significant impact on the organization
- That have participation or leadership from our parish members.

Using those criteria, we made the difficult decision to deny grants to five organizations.

Of the remaining organizations, we allocated \$32,997 to 15 organizations, as well as some money to Father Jesse's discretionary funds.
