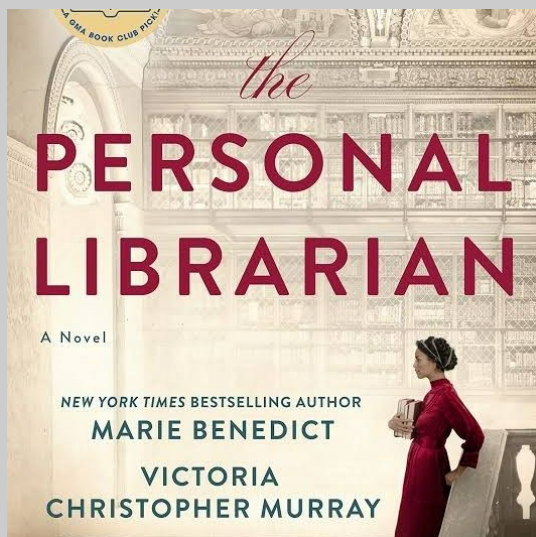


Happy Father's Day weekend! We do have Sunday school this week, and I look forward to seeing you all Sunday!

Donate to Companion Diocese Partners in South Sudan An update from the Commission on Global Ministry

While Sudan faces a surge in violence, the Diocese of Chicago's **Commission on Global Ministry** has been in frequent contact with longtime friend of the diocese, Archbishop Joseph Garang Atem, and his staff strategist for refugee assistance, Ajak Manyang, whose photos and reports inform this update:

For the past few months, deadly violence has erupted in the country of Sudan as two competing generals have fought for control of the country. Thousands have died, been injured, or lost all their possessions. Tens of thousands have fled the war-torn area for neighboring countries, including South Sudan, where many people fled years ago during that region's civil war.

Conservative estimates suggest that more than 40,000 refugees have crossed the border with South Sudan, putting tremendous burdens on the resources of the country. Archbishop Joseph Garang Atem of the Upper Nile Internal Province of the Episcopal Church of South Sudan, which includes the Diocese of Chicago's companion Diocese of Renk, South Sudan, has made an **urgent appeal for financial assistance** to support the refugees who have nothing but the barest necessities.

Habitat for Humanity—an Outreach Partner

With very grateful hearts the Outreach Team acknowledges Larry Quinlan for his long-time leadership with our local Habitat for Humanity affiliate, Joyful Hands Partnership. Larry has served on the board for 24 years and put in countless hours of project management and elbow grease. During that time the Partnership was able to build nine new homes and remodel another six existing structures. The Outreach granting process has donated many thousands of dollars to build affordable housing for members of our community via this partnership and continues to be supportive of the mission. We are now seeking 2 representatives from St. Michaels to serve on the Joyful Hands Partnership board.

To remain a member of the Partnership, two members of St. Michaels will need to be appointed to serve on the board. It would be beneficial, although not required, that the representatives have construction knowledge and/or excel at coordinating volunteers and fund raising. More specifically board members will be required to attend one monthly board meeting and participate monthly in at least one Saturday morning worksite during construction season.

When the Partnership was originally formed by Barrington area churches the mandate was that the homes were to be in the Barrington school district. Today it has become difficult to find affordable properties in the district, forcing the Partnership to look outside of the school district. Also today, only three of the original eleven churches are still involved with the Partnership, St. Michael's being one. Each church committed to sponsor two board members, provide volunteers for work sites, and provide financial support. Finding two board members from our congregation is imperative to remaining affiliated with the Habitat cohort.
