Summary of the Vestry Meeting of July 19, 2021 - 7:00 p.m. – Virtual Meeting*

- A quorum being present, Ann Kimes called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.
- Fr. Perkins offered the opening prayer.
- The agenda was approved as presented.
- The minutes of the June 21, 2021 meeting of the Vestry, and the minutes of the July 11, 2021 special meeting of the parish, were approved as presented.
- The Financial Statements for June 2021 were reviewed and approved as presented.
- Jill Anderson and the Vestry discussed LGBTQ+ pride and ideas to help St. Michael's feel more inclusive.
- Following an update on the 128 W. Hillside Avenue residence, the Vestry approved the process for next steps pertaining to sale of the property.
- It was noted that work to move forward with the rectory kitchen improvement project is continuing.
- Melissa Buckley and Gwynne Johnston provided an update on the 'Barrington Gives Back: Concert & Cookout for a Cause' fundraiser event. Also, parishioner assistance is requested for event set-up and take-down. Carol Berman reported that the requested donation of shirts for Barrington Back to School Giving Day was successful.
- Ric Lindeen encouraged adult parishioners to volunteer to assist with the Youth Group Sturtz First Mission Work Week.
- Fr. Perkins reported on recent and upcoming activities and events, including a wedding, a funeral, the Special Meeting of the Parish on July 11, planning for the upcoming program year, plans for Kick-Off Sunday on September 12, plans for communication of St. Michael's events, and Blessing of the Animals in October.
- Ann Kimes noted the good amount of energy at St. Michael's, including at coffee hour.
- Fr. Perkins offered the closing prayer.
- The meeting adjourned at 8:14 p.m.
